

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

For Players, becoming a member of the Dorchester Netball Club involves:

- Attending training regularly.
- Informing coaches if absence is unavoidable
- Arriving ON TIME for training.
- Wearing t shirt, skort, hoodie and suitable training shoes to training sessions.
- Having long hair tied back.
- Removing all jewellery prior to arrival on court. Newly pierced ears should have studs covered in tape. Medical identity bracelets should be taped to wrist.
- Having short nails with no sharp edges.
- Not wasting other players' time with distraction and 'fooling around' during training.
- Treating your coach and Team Manager with respect.
- Keeping your coach or Team Manager informed of any problems or injuries you may have which affect your play.
- Supporting your club in competition whenever possible.
- Accepting the umpire's decision as right with good grace and not arguing.
- Following the safety rules of this club.
- Treating your fellow players with respect (we all need to learn and can all improve).
- Not doing something to someone that you wouldn't want done to yourself.
- Setting a good example to younger players.

Remember, netball is a team sport and every team member is important – encourage your team mates!
